Stories of Khojis: Ashiq's Journey to Reconnect with Nature

For Ashiq, a Khoji from the 5th edition of The Great Indian Treasure Hunt, the forests of Nilambur were more than just a backdrop for an environmental project—they became a mirror, a teacher, and a source of deep inner reflection.

Ashiq recently participated in a one-day Invasive Plant Removal Project at the Karimpuzha Wildlife Sanctuary, nestled within the breathtaking Nedunkayam rainforest in Kerala. The initiative was organized by Wild Explorers, led by acclaimed wildlife photographer and nature educator Sadique Ali VM, in collaboration with the Kerala Forest & Wildlife Department.

The mission was clear: to help restore native vegetation and support wildlife conservation by removing invasive plant species that disrupt the natural ecosystem.



The day began not with action, but with awareness. Ashiq and the other participants learned how invasive species like Mikania micrantha and Lantana camara rapidly spread, choking native vegetation and pushing wildlife—especially elephants—out of their habitat. The session also explored the link between these plants and the growing human-wildlife conflicts across India. Following the session, the group ventured into the forest. Each person took on the difficult task of uprooting

invasive plants.

Despite the group's best efforts, only a small section could be cleared—a powerful reminder of how overwhelming and time-consuming ecological restoration truly is. The effort also gave him new appreciation for the tireless work of forest officers and grassroots conservationists, who continue these efforts year-round.



Midway through the work, the skies opened. Heavy monsoon rain came pouring down. But instead of stopping, the group kept going. Some laughed, some danced, and some simply stood still, taking it all in.

"There was this moment in the rain when I wasn't thinking about time or outcomes or plans. I just felt alive. The forest, the rain, the people—it felt like the Earth was letting us in," Ashiq shared.

He came back with mud on his clothes, stories in his heart, and a deeper sense of responsibility towards the environment. The project, though symbolic in scale, was powerful in intention. It reminded him—and everyone involved—that real change often begins with small, consistent acts of care.

As a Khoji, Ashiq's journey is about more than learning skills; it's about discovering meaning through action.

Leadership Beyond Borders: Abhilash Leads Dialogue on Transformative Leadership with Africa's Rising Leaders

We are thrilled to share that Abhilash John, founder of Khoj, recently conducted an impactful session with emerging young leaders across Africa as part of the Leadership and Governance Program organized by the Tyrone Havnar Foundation. As a featured speaker during Week 1 of the three-week virtual leadership series, Abhilash led an interactive session on "Foundations of Transformative Leadership". Speaking to a diverse group of aspiring changemakers from across the African continent, he shared his personal journey—from leaving a conventional job to walking the path of social change through volunteering, leadership, and community building.





In his session, Abhilash emphasized that true leadership begins with self-awareness and purpose. Drawing from his work with Indian youth through immersive learning journeys, he guided participants to reflect on their own values, the challenges facing their communities, and the importance of leading with empathy, courage, and integrity. Through stories of grassroots initiatives, rural experiences, and failures that led to learning, Abhilash inspired participants to look beyond positional leadership and explore authentic leadership rooted in service.

The session was part of a larger initiative by the Tyrone Havnar Foundation to equip young trailblazers with critical skills in leadership, governance, and civic engagement. The program includes sessions by other global leaders such as Kelisha Pandaram (South Africa) and Sristi KC (Germany), and features interactive challenges, real-time mentorship, and opportunities for global networking.
